

BELMONT & HARRISON CAREER CENTERS ANNOUNCE SCHOOL START PLANS

ST. CLAIRSVILLE – The Belmont and Harrison Career Centers will begin school with student orientations on Thursday, August 27 and Friday, August 28 to prepare for the many possibilities the 2020-21 school year may bring.

On Thursday, freshmen (9th) and juniors (11th) only will receive orientations, while on Friday, August 28, sophomores (10th) and seniors (12th) only will plan for the new school year.

Beginning Monday, August 31, the Belmont Career Center will operate with a “hybrid” model. Students will be divided into two groups, “A” and “B”, and they will each have their own calendar to follow. Group “A” will attend school on Tuesday and Thursday, and receive remote learning Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Group “B” will attend on Wednesday and Friday, and participate in remote learning on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. The hybrid model will be reviewed each week to determine when it is practical to return to school five days per week.

The Harrison Career Center will begin Monday, August 31, with full in school participation five days per week.
