What is Emergency Medical Technician?

Do you have an interest in a medical, public safety or dispatching career? If so, a career as an **Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)** might be just what the doctor ordered.

The curriculum includes basic anatomy, foundation of Emergency Medical Services, medical terminology, vital signs, patient assessment and medical report writing. After students complete all requirements of the program, they will take the National Registry EMT Exam which is the certifying exam for the state of Ohio. EMT certification is also a prerequisite to Paramedic Training.

The EMT program is available to 12th grade students only. Students may spend the full day at the Belmont Career Center for both lab instruction and academics; or a half day for lab instruction and a half day completing academics at their high school or College Credit Plus.
