Use of Funds

SWSF

All funds will be used to provide mental health services, physical healthcare services and homeless services to our students. The district has contracted with the East Central Ohio ESC (ECOESC) to provide Health Care Professional services (School Nurse) to our students, as well as, Prevention Specialist Service (Mental Health). These are full time positions that is utilized throughout the district. The district also employs a full-time school guidance counselor who works closely with a representative from Southeast Healthcare Services to provide mental health services to our students. Additionally, this guidance counselor is the districts Homeless Liaison.

DPIA

The funds are being used for multiple incentives. As part of our dropout prevention efforts the District is utilizing online credit recover support services through the East Central Ohio ESC and, Concentrated Conduct Adjustment Program (C-CAP) through the Belmont County Juvenile Court. The District also employs instructors for In-School Suspension programs.

For School safety and security measurers the District has contracted with the Belmont County Sheriff's department and Harrison County Sheriff's department to provide SRO services at both our schools. Also included, the District has contracted with a vendor for Fire and Security monitoring and contracted with Public School Works to provide mandatory training for all staff.
